


where faith comes to life



# Making an impact



- Our News service has expanded to provide our own Christian perspective on the news seven days a week.
- We broadcast live from Edinburgh and Glasgow the day the referendum results were announced, after an unprecedented 86% voted for independence or to stay within the UK, with comment and analysis from MSPs and Church leaders.

- Premier Christian Radio negotiated a deal to re-broadcast **Priestland's Progress**, a ground-breaking documentary exploring Christianity, originally broadcast on BBC Radio 4. In the process we became the first commercial broadcaster to operate under licence by the BBC to rebroadcast a BBC Radio series.
- Roger Bolton's **Holy Places** series took Christians, including Cardinal Vincent Nichols, Ann Widdecombe and Rev Richard Coles, to places of spiritual significance.

- The **Inspirational Breakfast** show has been broadcast from around the UK. At each location, Premier hold an evening reception. Over 2,500 people have attended to learn more about Premier.




- During the World Cup in Brazil, Premier presented daily features on the growing church there, and crossed live to the country to follow the progress of Christian footballers taking part in the competition.
- **Shed Talk**, a new weekly show for men with Carl Beech of CVM, was launched as part of a joint initiative to reach 1 million men and enable them to begin a journey of faith.
- At Easter and Christmas we broadcast services from cathedrals and churches from across the UK.

- Daily prayer updates from Canon Andrew White, Vicar of Baghdad, followed the launch of #prayforiraq, in the light of murderous attacks in Iraq and Syria by ISIS.
- Premier Gospel, which celebrates its fifth year in 2015, broadcast from Uganda, USA, Ghana and the United Arab Emirates last year, with guests including Grammy winners, Hollywood actors and leading politicians.
- Artists supported by Premier Gospel have won major awards, including two of the six finalists in the BBC Gospel Choir of the Year, and the winner of the prestigious MOBO Awards 2013.

2014 was an exciting year for Premier in terms of new media, as it saw the relaunch of our family of websites to a great reaction from our supporters. Radio listeners can now hear all shows again on Premier Christian Radio and Premier Gospel, subscribers can read full online versions of our magazines on *Premier Christianity*, *Premier Youthwork* and *Premier Childrenswork*, and premier.org.uk provides our visitors with the latest and best news affecting Christians, with everything from local issues to global stories. Our news team populate the




website regularly throughout the day, meaning that premier.org.uk is your one-stop-shop for news from around the world from a Christian perspective.




**Also packed with relevant and timely articles, inspiring videos, interviews with well-known figures, practical resources and, of course, the best of our radio shows ready for you at any time at the touch of the button – these sites aim to help bring you closer to God and equip you to reach out to your community.**

We welcome and encourage healthy debate by posting questions and articles on our social media accounts; we've found that our 75,000 followers use Premier platforms as a place for daily debate around the issues affecting them. We've also seen a growing response to our weekly Ignite e-newsletter, where around 90,000 recipients have read, watched and listened to stories from across the Premier family, among which the most popular have been 'How I reacted when my daughter became a Muslim' and 'Young, Christian & gay' and 'Do people think that Jesus rose again?'.

This world of great content, including free downloads and sample magazines, attracted over 5 million visits to our websites and around 2 million views of our videos.

# Print


Over 350,000 people read our magazines and a further 150,000 people receive our *Voice of Hope* bi-monthly daily devotional.


*Premier Youthwork* produced a special edition for young people, made by young people. A team of eight youngsters came for an intensive work experience programme, where they took the lead in shaping and crafting the August 2014 issue. Over 20,000 were distributed at youth festivals across the country.

*Premier Childrenswork* continues to grow after its launch in 2012. A new paradigm series gathers the leading thinkers and practitioners in children's ministry to reflect on what the future of children's work might look like.

*Premier Christianity* subscriptions exceeded 10,000 for the first time in four years, at a time when many magazines are declining. The cutting edge editorial and striking design has attracted much comment, while Twitter followers to this title have reached 10,000.

*Voice of Hope* includes 40 pages of Bible-based devotions to help encourage and build Christian faith. Based on UK-based Dr Micha Jazz's popular weekday *Be Still And Know* broadcasts on Premier Christian Radio, these distinctive Bible reflections include a prayer and a practical question to help the reader apply scripture to daily living.





# Making an impact in the **Community**

## CAMPAIGNS

Premier supported the Modern Slavery Bill, a cross-party initiative going through Parliament, and called on the government to ensure that the Modern Slavery Bill would create a legislative framework to outlaw slavery in the UK.

The Premier audience showed their strong support for our calls for the legislation to include the installation of a strong Independent Commissioner, a focus on victim support and legislation against supply chains to ensure that the bill was fit for purpose. Over 30,000 Premier supporters added their voice and spoke up for those who aren't allowed one.

## FEED THE HUNGRY

Premier teamed up with Feed the Hungry to send bags to churches around the country for congregations, schools and youth groups to collect food. Around 280 churches gathered 24,000 bags of food which were distributed to foodbanks in time for Christmas.

## UNBELIEVABLE THE CONFERENCE 2014

Unbelievable? The Conference 2014 was the fourth annual event linked to Premier Christian Radio's flagship apologetics and theology debate show *Unbelievable?* Justin Brierley was joined by over 800 delegates at Methodist Central Hall Westminster to address common objections to Christianity and hear from leading thinkers including Os Guinness on the evidence for the Christian faith.

## GOSPEL WEEK

In June 2014 Premier Gospel ran a week of free concerts across London. Over 2,000 people enjoyed a range of music, with live performances from the best UK gospel artists.

## YOUTHWORK SUMMIT

Over 1,000 youthworkers attended the Youthwork Summit organised by *Premier Youthwork* in partnership with Urban Saints and Youthscape at !Audacious Church in Manchester to hear 40 speakers at a one-day TED-style conference.

## CHRISTIAN NEW MEDIA CONFERENCE

Over 500 delegates attended the fourth Christian New Media Conference and were inspired, envisioned and challenged by the 38 expert speakers on the day. This was followed by the seventh Christian New Media Awards and dinner which celebrated and encouraged excellence in Christian engagement online.

## PREMIER LIFELINE

Premier Lifeline: the national Christian helpline, offering a listening ear, emotional and spiritual support and prayer, answered 68,598 calls from people in need. In 2014 we launched our new number, 0300 111 0101 and partnered with Christian listening services in Plymouth, Coventry, Hull and Scunthorpe through our new telephone system to ensure maximum support to the callers.



## PREMIER'S MIDLANDS/WALES OFFICE

was established in 2014 with a dual strategy of developing key contacts in the region to raise Premier's profile, as well as engaging directly with the region's supporters and listeners to ensure Premier responds most effectively to their needs.

A Council Of Reference has been established to ensure strong links within churches and key networks, and a regional listener board has been established. Guests and news stories from across the Midlands and Wales have featured on-air and contributed to articles in our magazines and online and we're excited to be reaching a bigger audience than ever in the region.

## PREMIER'S NORTHERN OFFICE

covers Scotland down to North Yorkshire in the south, and west to the Cumbrian coast, with regular links to 888 churches. In 2013 we established a regional Council of Reference, our overarching governing body, to ground and support our strategic aims with representation from churches and key organisations across the region.

Regional projects have included Re-Connect, Premier's response to the growing number of isolated people in this area. Many Christians with reduced mobility feel isolated from friends, family and their local church. Re-connecting these often lonely Christians with their local fellowship, introducing them to the ministry of Premier Lifeline and providing over 350 digital radios has helped hundreds enrich their spiritual life.

**'Re-connect is an important initiative which recognises the importance of each Christian and their place in the Body of Christ; giving more elderly or frail members the opportunity to listen to Christian radio is an important way to help them keep in touch. I warmly commend this imaginative idea.'**



# Finances

## At a glance

Our financial year to September 2014 has been a difficult one, resulting in a loss for the year. However, donation income has increased and a lot of the expenditure has been on one-off projects which will bring a long-term benefit.

### INCOME

Our income culminated in a successful year-end appeal in September 2014. Our overall donation income increased by 9.5% which is a testament to the commitment of our supporters to Premier's vision.

Key areas of donation growth have been in our major donor programme and our direct debit donations. Our direct debit income gives us some certainty to allow us to enter long-term agreements, for example with transmission providers; this income increased by 10% in the past year. The major donor programme entered its first full year in 2013-14 and showed as an increase of 43%.


Commercial income has also increased in our radio and online sales. Magazine advertising and subscription income dipped a little in the year but have not had a major effect on income.

### EXPENDITURE

During the year we have carried out a number of new initiatives which have increased costs. We launched *Voice of Hope* which is mailed nationwide, it has been well received and helps supporters in their faith journey, as well as providing news and information about Premier's ministry.


We have re-launched our main websites which have dramatically increased visits to our sites, which in turn means that more people are accessing the great resources and Christian news we provide; this also benefits our web advertising income.

We have rebranded the organisation with new logos for all our brands, which has had a positive effect on our sales and donation income. The work of our supporter contact team has increased significantly, which has led to the large increase in regular giving, and as this giving is likely to continue for many years, Premier will benefit in the long term from this investment.



We do not hold large reserves and are dependent on the ongoing support of our many donors who have given generously in the past, and we pray will continue to do so.


In those early days, thousands of Christians signed petitions to let the Radio Authority know of their personal support for such a station. But they went a step further. Thousands pledged to give each month to show
